RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
PACIFICA SCHOOL DISTRICT DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE EDUCATION PARCEL TAX
ELECTION HELD June 7, 2016 AND AUTHORIZING THE SAN MATEO COUNTY
CONTROLLER TO LEVY THE EDUCATION PARCEL TAX

WHEREAS, in November 2011, voters in the Pacifica School District ("District") authorized the District to levy a special tax of One Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$118.00) per parcel for five (5) years expiring June 30, 2017 with the 2016-17 Tax Roll;

WHEREAS, the existing special tax is set to expire at a time when state funding is inadequate and insufficient to provide the high-quality education our community expects and our students deserve; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the District adopted Resolution 2016- 03-02-A ("Parcel Tax Resolution"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", at its March 2, 2016 meeting ordering an election to authorize a special tax to renew and extend the existing special tax and authorizing necessary actions in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2016-03-02-A, an election for a special tax was called and held on June 7, 2016 ("Parcel Tax Election"); and

WHEREAS, notice of the Parcel Tax Election was duly given; and

WHEREAS, the Parcel Tax Election was duly held and conducted for the purpose of voting on the special tax measure ("Measure") which read:

Without increasing taxes, to protect approximately \$1.3 million annual local funding that cannot be taken by the State, shall Pacifica School District renew expiring local funding, protect quality education in local elementary/middle schools, enhance math, science, history, reading/writing programs, attract/retain qualified teachers, support well-rounded education like art/music programs, computer/technology instruction, libraries and support struggling students, at \$118 annually for 10 years, with citizen oversight, senior citizen exemptions, and no funds for administrators?

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the San Mateo County Chief Election Officer's certified Statement of the Vote, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, it appears from the certified Statement of the Vote that two-thirds or more of the votes cast on the Measure were in favor of approving the Measure; and

WHEREAS, the Board has evaluated the financial needs of the District to determine that the One Hundred Eighteen Dollar (\$118.00) special tax be levied beginning July 1, 2017 for ten (10) consecutive years and that it renew and extend the prior special tax; and

WHEREAS, the District requires the services of the offices of the San Mateo County Controller and the Tax Collector to levy and collect the education parcel tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The canvass by the San Mateo County Chief Elections Officer as shown in the certified Statement of the Vote is hereby ratified, confirmed, approved and entered upon the minutes of this meeting.

Section 2. More than two-thirds of all votes cast at the Parcel Tax Election on the Measure were in favor of the Measure, and the Measure passed.

Section 3. The Board authorizes special tax charges to be established at One Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$118.00) for each non-exempt parcel of land for ten (10) consecutive years, beginning on July 1, 2017 and ending on June 30, 2027; and

Section 4. The Board authorizes the special tax to renew and extend the expiring special tax as of July 1, 2017; and

Section 5. The District respectfully requires and authorizes the San Mateo County Controller to apply the special charges to individual tax assessments on the County Tax Roll for each consecutive year such charges have been authorized, in accordance with the documents supplied by the District, and authorizes the San Mateo County Tax Collector to collect the taxes at the same time and in the same manner as the general County taxes are collected.
